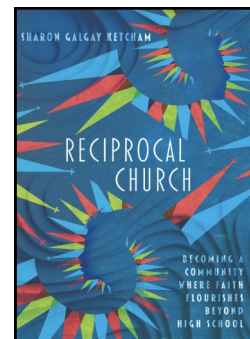

### What: The Lessons

\*Bring a side for our cook-out lunch.

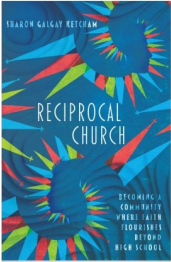
\*Parents are responsible for transportation to Somerset.

**Week 1**—Pray that God would receive all glory and praise from this trip. Pray that our words and deeds would point to Him, and Him alone. May all of our eyes be opened to just how BIG our God is. The God of Moncks Corner is the same God of France. He is “the one who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty”.

**Week 2**—Pray for our fundraising efforts as we continue to work individually, as we invite others to join this mission by giving financially, and as we partner with local businesses as a team to raise funds.

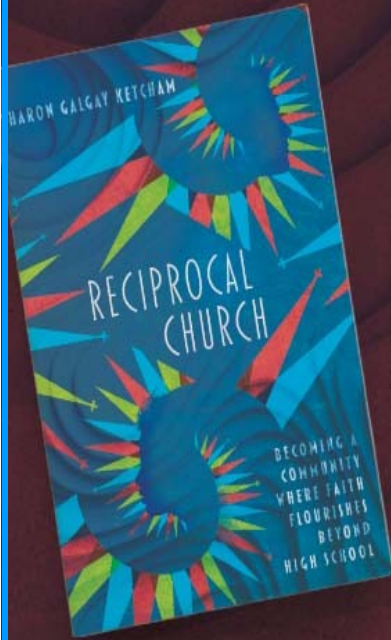
