

Week 1—Pray that God would receive all glory and praise from this trip. Pray that our words and deeds would point to Him, and Him alone. May all of our eyes be opened to just how BIG our God is. The God of Moncks Corner is the same God of France. He is "the one who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty".


Dear Church Family,




