Hands of Christ is a ministry of our church that reminds us how big the body of Christ is. Several Presbyterian churches throughout the Lowcountry participate in this back-to-school distribution. We have many parts, but we are **ONE body.** We have many distributions sites, but we have **ONE hope.** We have many volunteers, but we have **ONE faith.** We have different ways to serve, but we have **ONE Lord.**

"2019 Week Three Recap"

This year we served 4268 children during 22 distributions at 16 sites in six counties showing Christ's love. "Guestimating" an average 60 minimum of volunteers per site, times 4 hours per distribution, times 22 days of distribution comes up to 5280 volunteer hours --- and that does not include what the Operations team does during the three weeks prior to and during the distribution _____

(probably another 2500 volunteer hours) nor preparation and clean up by our host congregations. Wow! Thank You! Thank YOU!

Get Ready for Christmas Shoeboxes!

This is the 26th year our church has contributed shoe boxes to be given to children all over the world! Folders and labels are available but I need to mention a few things:

- Please use a <u>regular</u> size shoe box or one from Samaritan's Purse. Mickey and Hugh Smith have a supply of these.
- Please **fill** your box full, if at all possible.
- We are **not** to send candy, toothpaste, liquids, war toys, etc. (see folder on display table)
- Please check a **designated sex and age** to receive your box.
- Please place a rubber band around your box. Checks or money for shipping should go just inside your box.

I know this is early, but a lot of items have been on sale at Walmart recently. This is a good way for children, especially, to participate in a helpful mission activity. After delivery of the boxes, in which materials in "their language" will be included, classes are offered to teach about God, Jesus, and the Bible. Families are brought to Christ through this effort.






