1. <u>NEW!</u> Online Giving via First Presbyterian's website by visiting the Giving page at *firstpcmonckscorner.org/giving/*

You may make a one-time donation or set up recurring donations scheduled weekly, every two weeks, monthly or yearly.

2. <u>NEW!</u> Log in directly to Breeze at *firstpresbymc.breezechms.com*. Create an account or sign in.



<u>NEW!</u> Use Breeze's mobile app by entering firstpresbymc as the church ID when starting the app. The Breeze app can be found in the App Store for iOS and the Google Play store for Android. Search for Breeze Church Management and look for the sailboat icon.

NOTE: It is important that whenever you login or make any one-time donation you use your same email address every time to insure accurate reporting of your giving. All information in Breeze is linked via email addresses.

If you should need assistance and would like for a member of the church staff to set up your account profile and/or recurring giving, you may complete the form on the next page and turn it into the church office.

The Breeze Church Management system allows for you to view and manage your account profile by editing certain information. You may also view other members' public information. Beginning in January, all your giving will be recorded in Breeze and you will be able to view your giving history at any time.
