COVID-19 Response Plan - Phase 2 - Q & A

As members of Christ's Body, we have agreed to live by faith and not by fear; but we have also agreed to act in wisdom towards our members and guests as we patiently and deliberately step into our reopening efforts. In Phase 2 of our Response Plan, we are offering in-person worship services outdoors as we did during the June 7 communion service. Here are answers to questions you may have as we take this next step in our plan:

When and where will services be held? Sunday, July 5th at 9am, we will begin in-person worship (weather permitting) on the church's front lawn. These services will continue through the summer.

Will childcare be provided?

Out of an abundance of caution, childcare will not be provided during this phase. Families with young children are encouraged to bring picnic blankets and participate in worship as you're

Should I bring a chair?

Yes, bring your favorite beach or tailgate chair or bring a blanket for your family.

I want to gather, but I'm not ready to shake hands and give hugs. Is that OK?

Out of love for one another, physical distancing of six feet will be rigorously maintained during this phase. We are asking everyone to hold off on shaking hands and hugging.

What if I'm not ready to gather with others, even with social distancing measures in

We encourage any and all who are hesitant to gather in person to please stay home until they are comfortable. Continue to worship and pray at home; the service will continue to be available on-line.

Should I wear a mask?

Masks are welcomed, but not required since we are worshiping outside.

What if it rains?

In the event of rain, a cancellation notice will be sent out via Facebook. The worship leaders will moved indoors where the worship service will be closed to the public and streamed online.

How long will this phase last?

Nobody knows. The session will continue to monitor activities concerning COVID-19 and will stay in sync with the recommendations of our leaders and the trends in our community.

Minutes in a Minute

On Monday, June 15th the Session of First Presbyterian Church:

- Opened with prayer and devotion led by Elder Suzie Wilson
- Approved minutes from the May Stated Meeting
- Continued to observe and discuss the churches response to Covid-19
 - After lengthy discussion, decided to remain in Phase 2 (no indoor in-person worship) yet move the live streaming to take place on the church lawn (weather permitting) so that people can attend worship in person outside
- Received reports from each ministry team
- Closed with praver

Renovation Update

After an awful lot of digging, we finally found a window manufacturer who would build replacement sashes for windows they didn't make. We worked through the particulars of their sash design, and we decided to order a "test sash" to be 100% sure everybody on both ends was speaking the same language in terms of design and measurements. We felt it would be wise to do that before ordering 40+ custom built sashes that could not be returned. We ordered the test at just about the exact time in which the Covid-19 shutdown occurred, so it took us almost 10 weeks to get the test sash. Here's the good news: The sash fit beautifully and all of the rest of the sashes are ordered and payed for. We were able to get substantial pricing breaks from both the manufacturer (Windsor) and the supplier (Builders First Source) which will enable us to remain well within our original budget. The proposed delivery window for the new sashes for the sanctuary is the week of July 13. Once we receive them, we will immediately begin working in the sanctuary.



Meanwhile, we plan to replace the floors in the fellowship hall and kitchen by the time work in the sanctuary begins so that we will always have worship space intact.

Once the windows are replaced, re-trimmed on the inside, and painting in the sanctuary is completed, we'll replace the carpet last. We anticipate the work in the sanctuary spanning at least two full weeks once it starts.

Fellowship Sunday, August 5


We're having Fellowship Sunday on August 5 with dinner on the grounds.
