Many of the individuals who receive wheelchairs do not have insurance or access to proper healthcare. For every wheelchair given out, Chair the Love includes a quilt or blanket. A special thank you to Pearl Miller and Janet Lucas for their faithful effort to make this donation possible. Over 15 lap blankets will be dedicated during the Worship Service on Sunday, July 31.

"Hearing the stories of recipients who have never had a chair before and yet have been disabled for decades is hard to comprehend when you live in the USA. We met a 44 year old man who has been unable to walk since birth. This was his first wheelchair. There are elderly people who have no access to the outside world unless someone in the family physically carries them outside for fresh air. To these people it isn't just a wheelchair. It is a miracle! It is a source of freedom, dignity, and hope. It is also a sign of love."
