A Note from Our Pastor

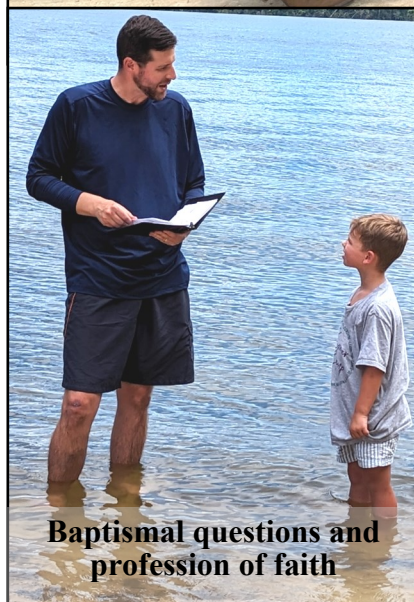

The following week (Sunday, August 20) we will have a time of welcome at FPC during our 11 a.m. worship. *God is a God of resurrection and new beginnings.*

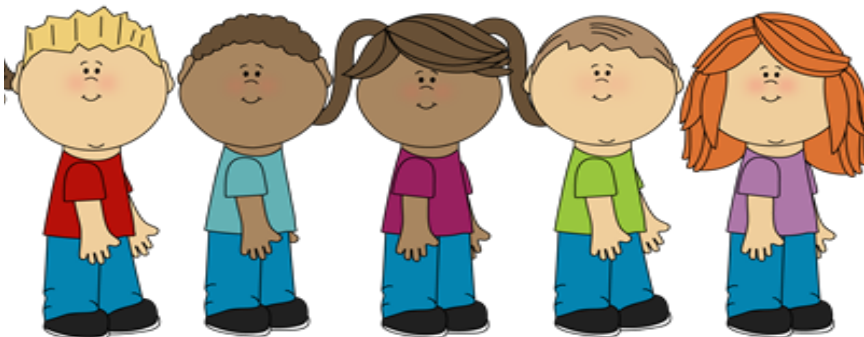


