A Note From Pastor Bo

## Celebrating Three Years of Ministry at Wildcat

April 1 marks the beginning of our fourth year of ministry at the Wildcat Senior Living Community. On this anniversary I wanted to briefly tell you about the history of our work and worship there, as well as share some exciting news with you about our current ministry to the residents.

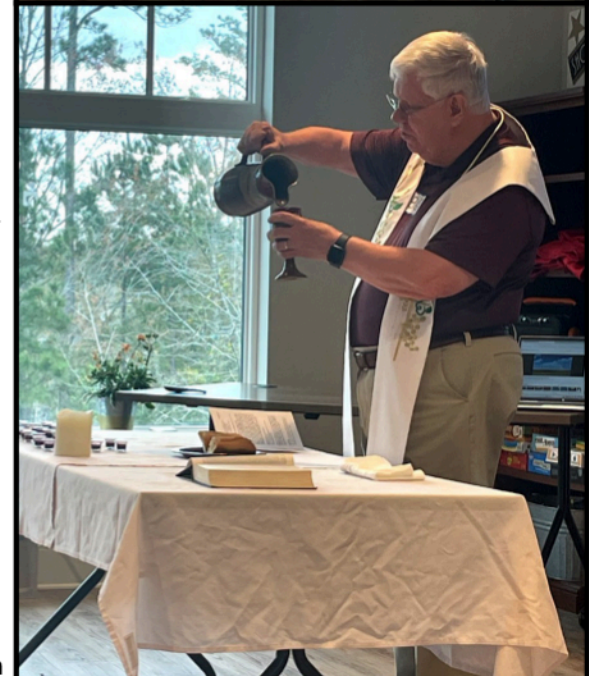
Wildcat opened its doors in February 2023. The facility director invited the Presbyterian Church of Cane Bay (PCCB) new church development group to a "Lunch and Learn" on March 6. Around 30 PCCB members toured the new facility and were treated to a delicious lunch with the staff and the few residents who'd already moved in. The congregation immediately recognized an opportunity to partner with Wildcat, serving the residents and expanding our ministry footprint into the new facility.

The CARE (Fellowship and Evangelism) Team sponsored a "Meet, Greet, and Treat" open house event at the community on April 1. This provided a wonderful opportunity to introduce the church to the residents and formed the beginning of what blossomed into our current ministry. We began by providing monthly worship services, Bible studies, and hymn sings, to the Assisted Living folks, but word quickly spread and some of the Independent Living residents soon joined in.

Our ministry at Wildcat evolved as our relationship with the residents grew. PCCB closed in the fall of 2023 and many in the congregation transitioned and joined our congregation here. I continued to serve the residents as their "unofficial chaplain," meeting and praying with them, leading Bible studies, hymn sings, and conducting funerals. God brought me to FPC in January 2024 and the Session approved my continued ministry at Wildcat. Ginny Doll and Halina Burke joined me in leading our services.

Beginning in 2024, we combined hymn sings with a Bible study. We studied the 42 "Miracles of Jesus" through 2024 and 2025 and added a ministry to the Memory Care Unit in 2025, reading to the residents and leading them in hymn sings. We started a study of the 38 Parables of

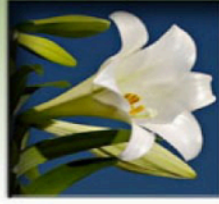

We accomplished a lot on our work day. We cut shrubs, cut grass, added fresh mulch to the playground, ate lunch and enjoyed each others fellowship.



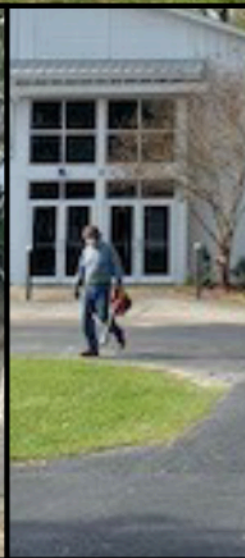

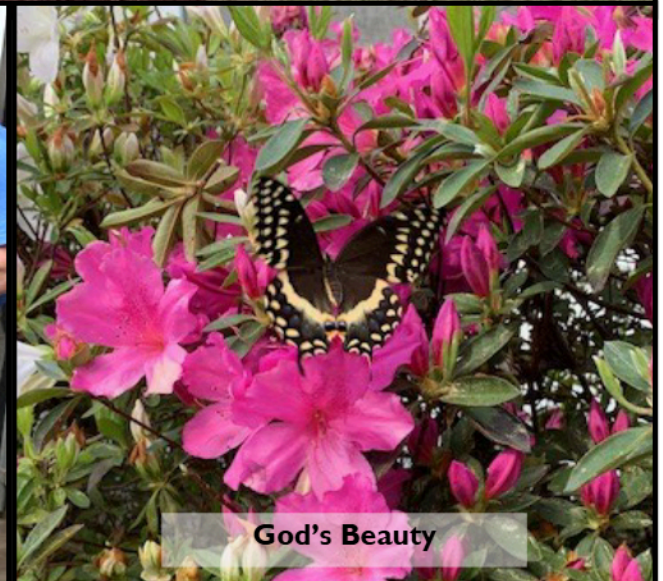
